(1-3) Print appropriate information. (4) Insert Documentation number (5) Insert year boat was built; if unknown leave blank. (6) Insert length of boat in feet. Drop the inches. Do not round off to the next foot. (7) Insert name of company that built the boat. If boat was built by owner or builder is unknown, please specify. (8) Insert Hull Identification number. All boats manufactured after November 1972 are required by Federal law to have a 12 digit Hull ID #. (9 - 13) Mark appropriate box. (14) Insert appropriate information on motor and trailer. If unknown leave blank. (15) Insert horsepower rating from the boat capacity plate. These plates were not required before 1972. If unknown, leave blank. (16) Toilet: mark appropriate box. (17) Enter the date the boat was purchased. (18) Fill in where the boat was purchased. **If the boat was purchased from a KANSAS DEALER submit with a form STD8 or bill of sale showing sales tax paid. If bought from an OUT OF STATE DEALER submit application with bill of sale showing sales tax paid in another state, or if no taxes paid, go to your county treasurer, pay the Kansas sales tax and submit with a receipt form you receive there.
