

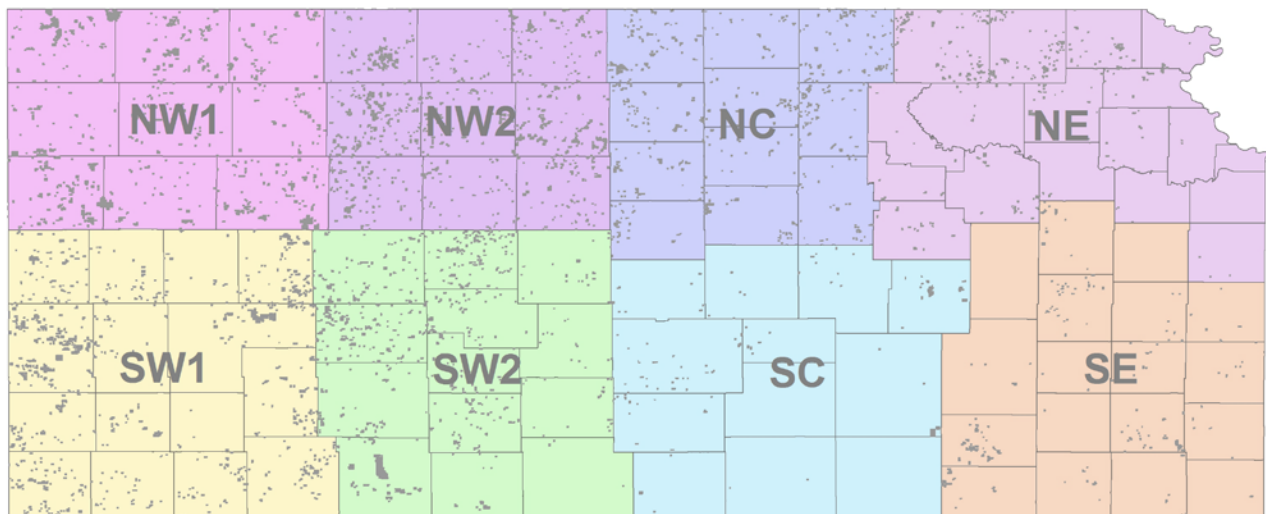
Adding KS WIHA Tracts to Google Maps









Note: Mobile device requirements for running Google Maps can be found [here](#).

- 1.) Download the appropriate *.kml files for the area of the state you will be accessing (See Map Below).
Note: All 8 files can be added to your mobile device. The statewide file had to be split up due to individual file limitations for importing to Google Maps/ My Maps.
- 2.) Once you have made sure that your device is supported (see link above), visit m.google.com/maps using your phone's web browser to download and install Google Maps for mobile.
- 3.) Log in to your Google Account if you are not already (you will need to create a free account if you do not already have one) and go to maps.google.com.
- 4.) Under 'My places' click the 'Create Map' button. Here you can add a title and description for the map then click on 'Import'.
- 5.) Browse for the downloaded *.kml file above, select it, click 'Open', click 'Upload from File' (repeat this process for each file downloaded).
- 6.) On your compatible mobile device, open Google Maps for Mobile, go to Layers, More Layers, My Maps, and select the map(s) you just imported to your account.
