- ◆ *Member* \$50 per year plus a \$5 daily fee

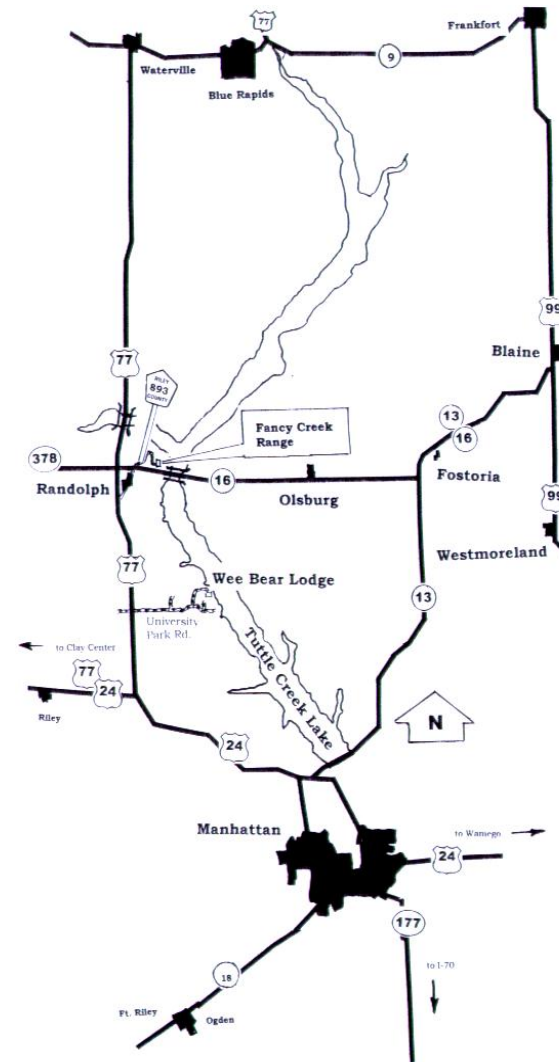
Additional Requirements

To establish a safe shooting environment open to the general public and families for Hunter Education, 4-H Shooting Sports, Scouting, Women's programs, Youth groups, and general recreational shooting.

History of the Range

- ◆ Planning started in the early 1990s
- ◆ FFCR is a spinoff of Riley County Fish & Game Association
- ◆ Range site was selected through cooperation with the Army Corps of Engineers and Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks
- ◆ Funding to construct the Range came from monies generated by the Pittman-Robertson Act, a Federal tax on sporting goods including firearms, ammunition, and archery equipment
- ◆ The Range opened in September 2002
- ◆ Electricity was made available to the Range by Westar's Green Team in 2007

Volunteers

- ◆ The Range is operated by volunteers
- ◆ Each Range has NRA Certified Range Safety Officers working when the Range is operational
- ◆ Our Range would not be open without all of our volunteers

Rifle Range

- ◆ 20 Firing Points
- ◆ Shooting available at 50 & 100 meters



Pistol Range

- ◆ 9 Firing Points
- ◆ Shooting available at 10 & 22 meters
- ◆ Shooting at 7 meters upon request on lanes 4, 5 and 6 only



50 Meter Range

- ◆ 12 Firing Points
- ◆ Shooting available at 25 & 50 meters
- ◆ Constructed with grants from the Pittman-Robertson Act, the National Wild Turkey Federation, the Justin Corbet Shooting Foundation, and the NRA Foundation.

NRA Kids Event at the Range

- ◆ Kids Event is scheduled for Saturday, June 30, 2012
- ◆ Instructional shooting clinic providing .22 rifles, BB Gun, black powder, archery, and more for youth ages 8-15
- ◆ Cost is \$10 per person or \$15 per person plus one friend

Rimfire Silhouette Shooting / BR 50 Match

Offered the second Sunday of the month (except April and July) from 10am – 4pm. (BR 50 match will start at 10:15 followed by Silhouette)

- ◆ Cost is \$10 per event or \$20 for the day
- ◆ Shoot chickens at 40 meters, pigs at 60 meters, turkeys at 77 meters and rams at 100 meters; scopes are allowed
- ◆ Only 22 short, long, or long rifle rimfire cartridges are allowed
